THE CRITERIA

- Demonstrates excellence, creativity and initiative in her business or profession
- Provides valuable service to improve the quality of life for others in her community
- Clearly serves as a role model for young women both personally and professionally

QUALIFICATIONS

- ATHENA Young Professional Leadership Award Nominees are 40 years of age or younger.
- ATHENA Young Professional Award Nominees may represent either the profit or not-for-profit sector.

 Previous ATHENA Young Professional Leadership Award Recipients are not eligible for nomination, however past nominees may be nominated again.

COMPLETING THE FORM

- You are encouraged to work closely with your nominee to complete their nomination.
- Nominations must be submitted using this nomination form and format.
- You may include supporting documents (articles, testimonials, etc.) with your completed nomination form.
- Deadline for submission: September 15, 2023 at 5pm.

THE PROCESS

A Selection Committee, made up of past ATHENA Young Professional Leadership Award recipients, will review all nominations and select the ATHENA Young Professional Award Recipient. The recipient will be announced at the Athena Leadership Luncheon on November 8, 2023 at the Sadie Jane.
